



ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

- Identified common barriers to student achievement
- •Created a form for teachers to identify at risk students at each interim and marking period:
 - Addresses Causes: attendance, effort, homework, etc.
 - Addresses Interventions: actions that the teacher took to increase the likelihood for student success

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

- The form serves as the initial step in the RTI, (Response to Intervention) process.
- •As part of the form's requirements, guidance counselors, parents, and department leaders are included on the form's submission and student's progress.
- Department leaders bring these concerns to the RTI committee, where additional interventions may be implemented.

COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS


- In collaboration with Schenectady County Community College, the High School is set to offer 18 new college courses for credit
- Next year, the high school will offer 25 SCCC classes with plans to add 3 more in 2017
- Students have access to 85 college credits through SCCC in addition to our current AP and IB courses and other college-level courses
