

 - Using Legos connected to holiday research (grades 3-5 and 8:1:2)
 - Using K'Nex to design a SeeSaw or a bridge (grades 3-5 and 8:1:2)
 - St. Patrick's Day knowledge designs using kinetic sand, Legos, and/or K'Nex (1st grade)
 - Coding (2nd and 3rd grade)


