- 1) Astria information section
- 2) Mission Statement
 - a. This scholarship will be awarded to one high school senior who attends the Clean Technologies & Sustainable Industries Early College High School ("Clean Tech ECHS") and will graduate in June 2015. The recipients of this scholarship must be interested in furthering their education in a two or four year institution and plan to continue their collegiate career in a STEM field.
- 3) Date Established – April 13, 2015
- 4) Scholarship Criteria
 - a. Scholarship recipients must meet the following criteria:
 - i. Currently enrolled in the Clean Tech ECHS as a senior graduating in the current spring semester
 - ii. Have an interest in furthering their education in a STEM field
 - iii. Applicant must have a minimal 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (current college transcript) and an 80 GPA on a 100 scale (current high school transcript)
- 5) How to apply
 - a. Submit an essay of 500 words or less as requested on the application
 - b. Submit transcripts (college and high school)
 - c. Submit two letters of recommendation; and
 - d. Complete the attached application and submit with the essay and letters of recommendation
 - e. Applicants may be required to perform an in-person interview with the Astria Scholarship Committee.
- 6) Amount of Award
 - a. There will be an annual scholarship of \$1,000 awarded to a senior from the Clean Tech ECHS graduating class. The scholarship will be comprised of two (2) \$500 per semester awards for up to 8 semesters. After the initial semester award winners must maintain a minimal 2.5 GPA each semester as detailed in the scholarship agreement. All award winners must sign the scholarship agreement in order to receive the award.
- 7) Application Deadline
 - a. Submit application with appropriate attachments to Lyndsey Wilcox by April 30, 2015.
- 8) There will be no distribution of the award if there are no qualified applicants, the chosen recipient does not continue his/her studies during the semester for which the award is intended, or there is limited availability of fund interest.
