**Frances Gray Post and Agnes Hayes Post Memorial Fund:** This scholarship is offered to women residents of the towns of Ballston, Milton or the Village of Ballston Spa who have been accepted for admission by an accredited nursing, laboratory technology, cytology, OT, PT Respiratory Therapy or medical imaging technology school program. They must maintain adequate grades and satisfactory academic progress. Other eligibility requirements may apply. This grant is renewable each semester per guidelines of administrator. Applications are available in the Guidance office. **There is no Deadline.**

**NYS Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Incentive Program:** The NYS STEM Incentive Program provides a full SUNY or CUNY tuition scholarship for the top 10% of students graduating in each New York State high school if they pursue a STEM degree in an associates or bachelor degree program and agree to work in a STEM field in New York State for 5 years after graduation.
