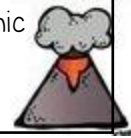
Words that Compare

Adjectives/adverbs ending in -er compare two nouns. For adjectives/adverbs ending in -ly, use more before the adjective/adverb.

Adjectives ending in -est compare more than two nouns. For adjectives/adverbs ending in -ly, use most before the adjective/adverb.

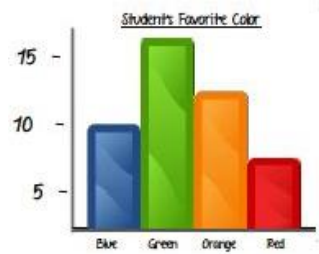
Reading: Vacation Under the Volcano
