Reading: Abe's Honest Words

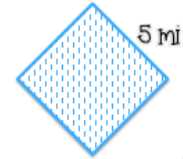
In honor of president's day, we will be using various texts about Abraham Lincoln and George Washington to learn about drawing conclusions and point of view.
