Reading: Somebody Loves you, Mr. Hatch

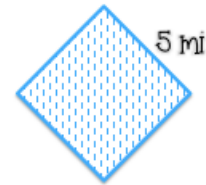
This week we will read two stories; Somebody Loves You, Mr. Hatch and Amos and Boris to review story structure and theme.
