Suffixes -able & -ible

A suffix is a word part added to the end of a word to change the meaning. Ex. **comfortable**
-able and -ible means capable or worthy of an action; therefore, comfortable means capable of feeling comfort, or relief.

Reading: Seed, Sprout, Pumpkin Pie

This week, we will continue to read a variety of Non-fiction texts. Our texts will be about the life cycle of a pumpkin, as well as an apple. Students will make learn about sequence (order) of events, compare and contrast the pumpkin and the apple, and make connections between these and the plants from science.
