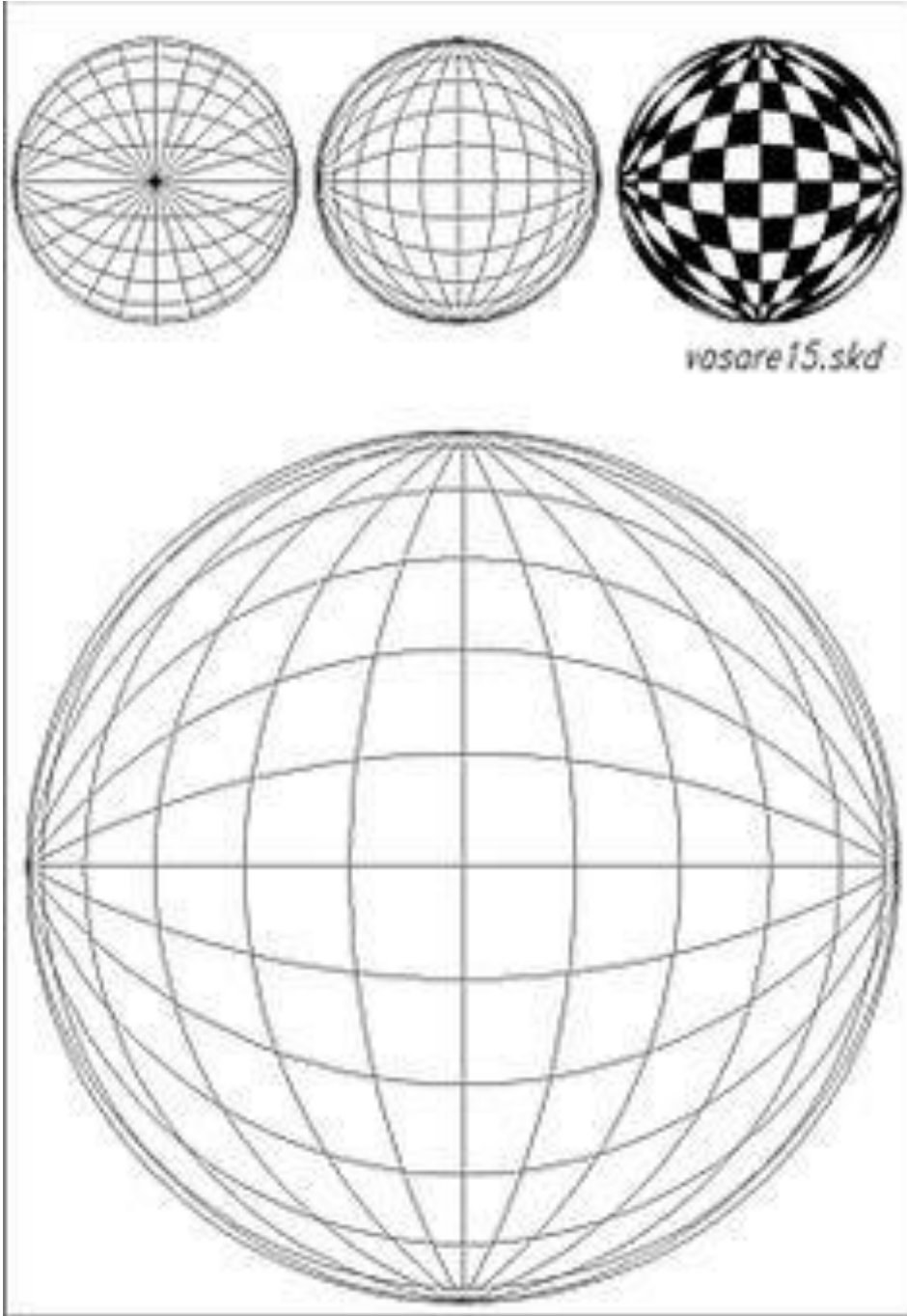


Op Art Converging Lines

Checkerboard Circle

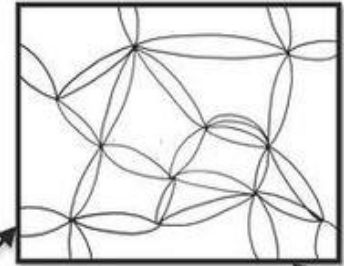
op art:

a style of abstract art that creates optical illusions with lines, shapes, and forms

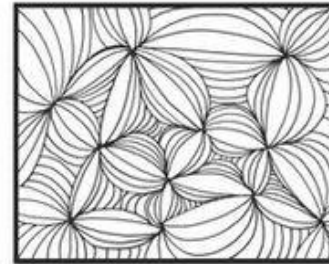


← step one:
draw 7 - 15 dots
randomly on your paper

step two: →
connect the dots with
curved lines.



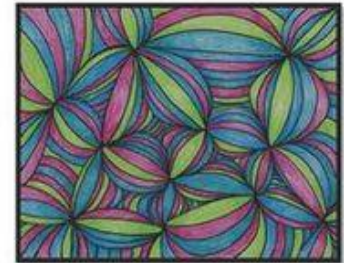
some curved lines should go off the page to an imaginary dot



← step three:
keep adding curved lines
from dot to dot, making
larger curves. add curved
lines until the page is full.

[*straight lines will make it look flat,
not 3-d]

step four: →
choose a color scheme
and color in your design.
create 3-d value by
pressing harder near the
dots and softer in the
middle of each section.

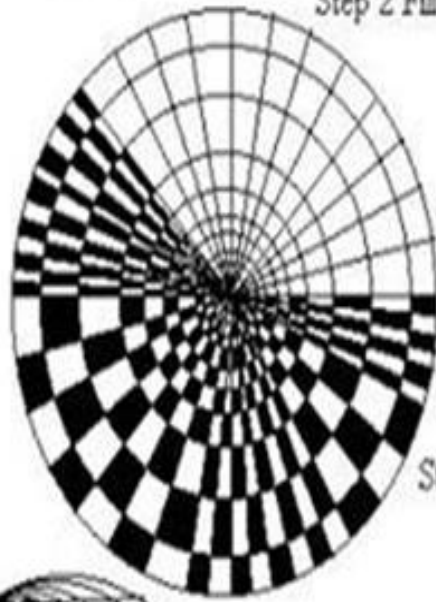

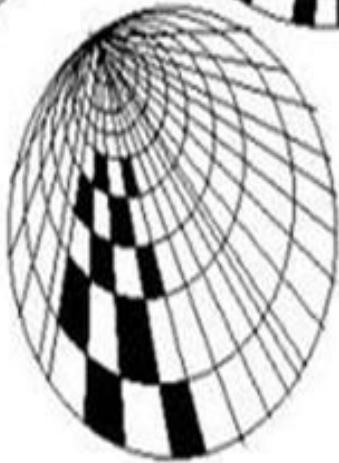
Step 1 Draw Circles
