Money by Grade Level

Grade 1:

Measurement & Data 1.MD.

Recognize and identify coins, their names, and their value.

Grade 2:

Measurement & Data 2.MD8.

Solve word problems involving dollar bills, quarters, dimes, nickels, and pennies, using \$ and ¢ symbols appropriately. Example: If you have 2 dimes and 3 pennies, how many cents do you have?

Grade 4:

Measurement & Data 4.MD2

Use the four operations to solve word problems involving money.

Number & Operations—Fractions

4.NF6

Use decimal notation for fractions with denominators 10 or 100. For example, rewrite 0.62 as $\frac{62}{100}$; write as a money amount and as a decimal in terms of dollars ($\$0.62$ and 0.62).
