

4th & 5th Grade Summer Math Activities



- ☀ Ask your child what time it is and what time it will be in ___ minutes.
- ☀ Ask your child what time you should leave for an appointment or activity, if you have to be there by 10:00 a.m. and it takes 25 minutes to drive there.
- ☀ Bake or cook with your child (helps with measuring, understanding fractions & talking about cups, ounces, tablespoons, etc.)
- ☀ Estimate the cost of your back-to-school supplies (use rounding to figure out the cost). Were you close?
- ☀ Figure out the start/end time when baking/cooking (elapsed time)
- ☀ Find the area and perimeter of your yard, room, garden, etc.
- ☀ Make a board game (or use a commercial board) and create word problem games cards
- ☀ Read books about math (see *Math Books for Children* on my website)
- ☀ Pay for items and figure out the change that you should receive in 2 different ways
- ☀ Play board games (*Battleship, Chess, Monopoly, Smath, Yahtzee, 99 or Bust*)
- ☀ Play card games (*Addition War, Multiplication War, Phase 10, Rummy, Uno*)
- ☀ Play *Tic-Tac-15* (or any other number). Make a tic-tac-toe board and use the numbers from a deck of cards. Players take turns picking a card & placing it on the board. The first player whose cards add up to 15 in a row, column, or on a diagonal, wins.
