Resolution #612 - Approval Renewal Agreement

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Ballston Spa Central School District, that the Renewal Agreement between the Office of Sheriff-Saratoga County and the District, to provide School Resource Officer (SRO) services for the 2021-2022 school year, be and is hereby approved.

Resolution #613 - Extended Summer School Year and Summer School Program Health and Safety Requirements

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Ballston Spa Central School District, its students, faculty and staff, administration, parents, and community have worked diligently to manage the COVID-19 virus during the 2020-2021 school year by following all health and safety requirements from the New York State Department of Health (DOH) and by extension the Centers for Disease Control (CDC); all educational requirements from the New York State Education Department (SED); all advisories from the Saratoga County Department of Public Health; and all legal and medical opinions from our District Counsel and Physician respectively regarding the management of the virus; and

WHEREAS, the District demonstrated the ability time and time again that it could respond quickly to any identified positive case while keeping students and staff safe from further spread of the virus; and

WHEREAS, the positivity rate for the virus is consistently below if not well-below 1% in both the Capital Region and in Saratoga County; and

WHEREAS, the CDC Community Rate of Transmission Risk classification for Saratoga County has hovered between Low and Moderate with an increasing number of surrounding counties being classified as at Low Risk; and

WHEREAS, with few exceptions, our school classrooms and our school buses are not air conditioned; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines from the NYS DOH for summer camps which may be run in the same school buildings as academic programs do not require students to wear masks or follow the other restrictions as detailed in the INTERIM GUIDANCE FOR IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION AT PRE-K TO GRADE 12 SCHOOLS DURING THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Ballston Spa Central School District respectfully requests that the Governor act immediately, or, in the absence of action by the Governor, that the NYS Legislature agree to meet in special session to act immediately, to align the academic program health and safety rules with the summer camp health and safety rules so that students, faculty and staff, and schools may host either or both programs while minimizing confusion from parents, student, and our communities and maximizing the learning of our students. The Board further respectfully requests that guidance for the Fall 2021 semester be released as soon as possible so that proper planning may take place to prepare our students, families, faculty and staff, and communities for what they can expect in
